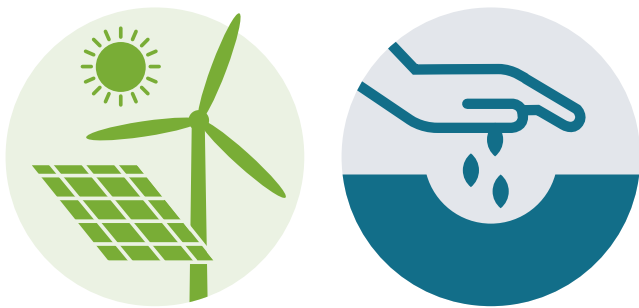


CIVIL SOCIETY ACCESS TO CLIMATE FINANCE IN THE CARIBBEAN

From 2016 to 2020, scoping study found:
