The process to elect the Representatives of the Public under the Escazú Agreement for the 2026–2030 term is now underway. This presents an important opportunity for Caribbean civil society to participate in the governance of the Agreement by registering to vote, considering candidacies and engaging in the regional electoral process. The electoral calendar and key deadlines were recently announced by the Secretariat of the Escazú Agreement.

## What to expect

The webinar will be led by the Caribbean's outgoing Representatives of the Public, Nicole Leotaud and Bishnu Tulsi, who will:

- Share their experiences serving as Representatives of the Public
- Explain the election process, including voter registration and candidacy requirements
- Discuss the role and why these elections matter for Caribbean civil society
- Answer participants' questions and explore how the region can mobilise ahead of the voter registration deadline

This webinar follows discussions during the recent Caribbean Post-COP4 Debrief, where the upcoming elections were highlighted as an important opportunity for Caribbean civil society engagement.

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### Key election dates

- 31 July 2026 – Deadline to register on the Regional Public Mechanism platform to be eligible to vote
- 10 August 2026 – Deadline for submission of candidacies
- 10–11 November 2026 – Elections of the Representatives of the Public

## Register to vote

To be eligible to vote in the election of the Representatives of the Public, **you must be registered with the Regional Public Mechanism by 31 July 2026**. If you are not yet registered, we strongly encourage you to do so as soon as possible to ensure you can participate in the election.
